## Nationals Weekly Update 18th February 2015

Six weeks to go and as you would expect it's all hands on deck leading up to the 2015 Falcon GT Nationals at Sandown International Raceway this Easter.

Since 11 Feb update we:

- Agreed roles and responsibilities with our recently on-boarded management services provider Republic Events Australia
- Worked through final Nationals merchandising detail with our merchandise supplier Khouri Work Wear
- Booked entertainment
- Affiliated the Falcon GT Club of Australia with CAMS a requirement for hosting the Sunday track day at Sandown. NB: We will also be supported by another CAMS affiliated motoring club who will facilitate the running of the event on the day. Track day details will be published shortly
- Btw, food/food vendor availability at Sandown across the Easter weekend will be provided by MRC/Sandown at the venue and these guys are experienced in catering for crowds so you won't go hungry and you won't be waiting for food
- Held discussion with potential MC and Guest Speakers Watch this space!
- Actively re-connected with our colleagues from the National Association of Falcon GT Clubs, including the vastly experienced Falcon GT judges from the member clubs
- Got out and about advertising the 2015 Falcon GT Nationals
  - The club was invited to provide a display at the massive Northern Classic Cruisers car show Sat evening 7 Feb in Melbourne suburb of Preston, where well known event organizer Nez Nemaj gave the Nationals some fantastic airtime during the event
  - We had a club display at the Geelong All Ford Day Sun 15 Feb where we had a huge 2015 Nationals Banner which received plenty of enquiries. We handed out hundreds of Nationals Flyers to patrons and the Event organizers put our flyer in every Rare Spares goodies bag handed out to over 1,500 entrants. As well, one of our members didn't waste the opportunity of airtime provided by K-Rock radio to speak about the Nationals

To date we have 170 entrants with more coming in every day. One car is being driven down from Darwin NT. Add that to the folks coming over from the WA, SA, Qld, NSW, Tas, & NZ and the 2015 Nationals event is actually shaping up as an "InterNationals".
