

Judging Requirement - Quick Reference

As previously mentioned this event is subject to NAFGTC Concourse Guidelines which should be read and clearly understood by entrants. These can be viewed at <u>www.nafgtc.asn.au</u>.

To ensure the smooth running of the concourse and the judges' access to your vehicle, listed here is a quick reference for you to note:

- JUDGES TO HAVE CLEAR ACCESS TO VEHICLES FOR JUDGING
- PLEASE RESPECT THE JUDGES AND MOVE AWAY FROM YOUR CAR WHILE THEY SCRUTINEER
 OR JUDGE YOUR VEHICLE
- VEHICLES MUST BE UNLOCKED, BOOT, BONNET OPEN AND SPARE, TANK AND JACK ON DISPLAY (WHERE POSSIBLE) LOGBOOKS, KEYS ETC MUST BE VISIBLE
- IF JUDGES CAN'T SEE OR ACCESS AN ITEM THEY CAN'T SCORE IT
- JUDGES WILL OPEN AND CLOSE DOORS, BUT TO FIRST CLICK ONLY
- SILVER LEVEL VEHICLES WILL BE ASSESSED AT SCRUTINEERING, GOLD LEVEL VEHICLES WILL
 BE INDIVIDUALLY SCORED
- READ THE GUIDELINES PRIOR TO THE EVENT TO DETERMINE HOW POINTS ARE ALLOCATED

- ASK THE JUDGES IF YOU ARE UNSURE WHICH CATERGORY IS BEST FOR YOUR VEHICLE
- MODERN ERA VEHICLES (BA-FG) NEED TO HAVE MILEAGE VISIBLE AND SALES DATE IF 500 KLMs PER YEAR IS CLOSE
- RESPECT OTHER VEHICLE OWNERS AND ASK PERMISSION BEFORE PHOTOGRAPHING OR EXAMINING PEOPLES VEHICLES
- RESPECT PEOPLES PRIVACY OF VEHICLES ID OR REGISTRATION
